Straub Benioff Medical Center is a fully integrated not-for-profit health care provider with a 159-bed medical center in Honolulu. Straub Benioff provides its patients with expert diagnoses and treatments for more than 32 different medical specialties, including bone and joint, heart, cancer, endocrinology/diabetes, family medicine, gastroenterology, geriatric medicine, internal medicine, women's health, vascular and urology. Founded in 1921, Straub Benioff is home to the Pacific region's only multidisciplinary burn care unit. The medical center consistently brings new technologies and innovative medical practices to Hawai'i, such as minimally invasive cardiac surgery and total joint replacement. In addition to the programs and services at the medical center, Straub Benioff includes a network of neighborhood clinics and a visiting specialist program that reaches throughout the state of Hawai'i. History

Straub Benioff Medical Center was founded in 1921 as "The Clinic" by Dr. George F. Straub. Dr. Straub conceived the idea of forming a group of physicians to provide better, more-specialized care for his patients. Straub Clinic & Hospital became an affiliate of Hawai'i Pacific Health on Dec. 21, 2001. Lynne and Marc Benioff made a transformational gift in March 2024 of \$100 million to Hawai'i Pacific Health for the redevelopment of the South King Street campus which is now known as Straub Benioff Medical Center.
